3. I will treat the guest director, choir coordinators and all other adults with respect as they are here to make sure I am safe and that all students learn and have an excellent musical experience.
4. During rehearsals, down time, in holding rooms before/after concerts, and in the concert venue itself I will not yell, run, or conduct myself in any way other than my best behavior.
5. I acknowledge that it is an honor to be selected to be in the all-state choirs as 700 students have auditioned and only 190 are selected to attend. I will conduct myself in the best manner possible to show that I am deserving of this selection.
Students MUST be in attendance FOR THE ENTIRETY OF ALL rehearsals at Red River High School in Grand Forks, ND. Students understand that there are performance attire requirements and agrees to follow them. Students must abide by all eligibility rules of NDHSAA and their school. Any use of tobacco, alcohol, drugs or unacceptable behavior (described above) will result in the student's dismissal from the All-State Choirs.

RESULTS and REGISTRATION

Results are posted on the ND-ACDA Website. Please note your choir and your part. Soprano II's in the Treble Choir are chosen from both alto and soprano auditions. Alternates are listed in the order they would be called in the case of an opening.

Directors will receive music for each participating student and a rehearsal set for themselves from Poppler's Music. Conductor notes, rehearsal, and performance files are becoming available at the ND-ACDA website. Thank you, parents and teachers, for helping ensure that our students arrive well-prepared!

Accepted students must register by Friday, December 6th, 2019.

- 1. Students and parents complete and sign the information / consent / commitment form located at the beginning of this document and return it to the director.
- 2. Director completes online student attendee registration form(s) online using the link at the ND ACDA website (one form per student.) This form asks about student t-shirt size, height, meal accommodation, and verifies that student and parent/guardian have signed the consent and commitment form.
- 3. Director completes one online school registration form using the link at the ND ACDA website. This form asks how many students are attending, and also for chaperone phone and meal information.
- 4. Mail the registration and meal fees. The \$45 per registrant fee includes Friday dinner, Saturday lunch, a t-shirt, and music. Please consolidate checks whenever possible. Schools who have not completed and postmarked registration by 12/6 will be charged a \$50 late fee. Please send all fees (conference & meal) to:

In the event that a selected student cannot participate in ND-ACDA Honor Choir, please notify a co-chair immediately via email (ndacdamljhhc@gmail.com) so that we can arrange for an alternate to take the open position.

- The director of the declining student will send the music on to the new participant
- The new participant's director will be notified and asked to submit an online registration form.
- If the switch is made before the deadline, then the alternate will be asked to submit a registration fee. If the selected student was already registered and the 12/6 deadline has passed, then he/she forfeits his/her registration fee, and the member who replaces him/her will not be asked to pay.

Attendance Policy: Students must be in attendance at all rehearsals to participate in the Honor Choir event. Students must abide by all eligibility rules of NDHSAA and their school. Any use of tobacco, alcohol, drugs or unacceptable behavior will result in the student's dismissal from the Junior High/Middle School All-State Choirs.

Chaperone Policy: While Regional and National ACDA Honor Choirs require that students be chaperoned by their parents, North Dakota ACDA allows a director to chaperone instances where this is not possible. During the event, chaperones are asked to be available, especially during non-rehearsal times to supervise. Due to behavior issues in previous years, chaperones must now be available before and after concerts to supervise their students in the holding rooms.

Schools will submit all chaperone information together and designate one "head chaperone." This may be a director. In case of an emergency, the head chaperone would be contacted first. Other numbers may be used if the head chaperone does not answer. The head chaperone would need to be aware of which chaperone(s) are connected with which students from each school in order to contact the most direct contact to each student.

Chaperones may prefer to eat with the students for dinner on Friday and lunch on Saturday. If so, please sign up for a chaperone meal plan, and submit \$20 per chaperone with the student's registration fee.
