

ND ACDA Women's Honor Choir February 7th and 8th, 2020 Grand Forks, ND

The ND ACDA Women's Honor Choir, consisting of women from eleventh grade through college, will take place February 7th and 8th. Registration begins at noon on Friday and the ND ACDA Women's Honor Choir will rehearse for two days under the direction of Carrie Tennant, founder and director of the Vancouver Youth Choir. The Women's Honor Choir will be featured on the North Dakota ACDA Conference Concert on Saturday, February 8th in the afternoon and they will perform at Friday night's Showcase Concert. Students must be in attendance at the rehearsals to participate in the honor choir event.

Each high school and college is invited to send at least one singer, but may send up to six. If two singers are registered, one should be a soprano and the other alto. If three singers are registered, they should complete an SSA trio. If you would like to send more than two trios, please email brandel1@fargo.k12.nd.us. The number of singers in the Women's Honor Choir will be determined by the smallest number of voices in a particular section in order to achieve a balanced ensemble and in the order of registration form submission. The postmarked deadline for submission of names is November 1st, 2019.

The registration fees are \$45 for HIGH SCHOOL and COLLEGIATE SINGERS. A fee of \$50 will be assessed for late registrations. Fees are due Nov. 15th.

*The registration fee covers the costs of music, Friday evening meal, Saturday noon meal and a t-shirt.

Please make checks payable to NDACDA. There will be **NO** refunds. Confirmation of honor choir membership, festival music and the schedule will be emailed to participating schools by the end of November. All participating teachers must be members of ACDA.

Check-In will be held at the ND ACDA convention site. Students are responsible for their own transportation to Grand Forks and to all rehearsals. Students are also responsible for their own lodging. Hotel information will be posted on the ND ACDA website. All high school students must be chaperoned by a teacher or parent.

Performance attire for the Friday night Showcase Concert is the NDACDA t-shirt and jeans. Performance attire for the Saturday night concert is the participant's school/college choral uniform (formal or robe). If a participant's school does not utilize a uniform, an **ALL BLACK** dress or pants outfit, which is at least knee-length may be worn.
