2021-2022 North Dakota ACDA Junior High / Middle Level Honor Choirs Audition Information

WHERE: Bismarck, St. Mary's Central High School WHEN: Friday and Saturday, February 4-5, 2022

WHAT: The Junior High / Middle Level Honor Choirs will consist of two 7th – 9th grade auditioned choirs: 100-voice Mixed Choir, and 90-voice Treble Choir. Each choir will rehearse for two days under the direction of guest conductors and will be featured at the closing concert of the North Dakota ACDA Conference.

Audition fee: Student audition fees are **7 dollars**.

COVID-19 Information: The COVID-19 pandemic is an ever-evolving situation, and our top priority is safety for our students, teachers, parents, and communities. In planning and holding this event, we are utilizing guidance from state and local government and health authorities as well as the NDHSAA. As circumstances and recommendations change, our event will also change. We will communicate any changes and possible cancellations as soon as we can. In the event of a cancellation, students accepted into the honor choirs will still have that distinction to use on scholarship applications, etc., and they will still be considered participants for the purposes of three-year awards.

STEP ONE: AUDITION

Please read the following instructions carefully. All forms, audition files, and one check per school/director must be submitted/postmarked by **Friday, October 15th.** Any auditions not meeting any of the stated requirements will not be considered.

PREPARE the Audition:

• **Solo 1:** Sing the first verse of "America" ("My Country 'Tis of Thee") **unaccompanied** in an appropriate key. Here are a few recommendations:

Sopranos – G above middle C Altos – Eb above middle C Tenors – A below middle C Basses – D below middle C

- Solo 2: Sing an age-appropriate prepared solo showing your best vocal quality within the first two
 minutes. Appropriate repertoire for the audition would be a sacred or secular art or folk song (folk songs
 preferred). Pop, Broadway, Gospel, and Contemporary Christian pieces are not appropriate. Judges will
 only listen to the first two minutes of the recording, so feel free to trim the piece accordingly.
- Please do not have your singer announce anything before they sing.

SAVE the Audition CORRECTLY:

Part-LastName-FirstName-Solo
 Part-LastName-FirstName-America

Bass-Cash-Johnny-Solo Soprano-Fleming-Renee-America

*Do not put the title of the solo at the end of the file label, just put "Solo" exactly as shown above. Do not use an abbreviation. Do not use an alternate abbreviation or title for "America."

- WHEN YOU SAVE: Do not use a space, period, comma... USE A HYPHEN. Spell out the entire part (Soprano- Tenor- Bass- Alto). This is important for proper sorting and file location.
- NO ADDED REVERB OR AUTO-TUNE. If your recording uses any noticeable audio manipulation including added reverb, it may be disqualified. Some recording programs like Garageband add effects

like reverb automatically, so please be sure to check that you are recording and exporting your files with no added manipulation or effects.

• We highly recommend sending in a test recording if you're not sure that your recording method works. Simply email a test file to ndacdamljhhc@gmail.com with TEST TRACK in the subject line. Do this BEFORE you start creating final recordings, so you have time to change methods if it doesn't work. If you're new to making recordings and need assistance, please email us at the provided address above.

SUBMIT Auditions:

• Upload your .mp3 files via the audition form. If you submit .wav, .mp4, .m4a, or any other type of file we will ask you to convert and re-submit with .mp3 files if time allows. You can select files from your device or from your own Google Drive. If you share files with us via your Google Drive, make sure you have permissions set to share with ndacdamljhhc@gmail.com.

Please confirm with your students and their parents that they aware of the dates and requirements of participating in ND ACDA ML JH Honor Choirs.

Candidate name, gender, grade, part auditioning for, if S2 is a good option, range, solo name Please make sure you enter students' names the way you will for registration and the way you want them listed in the program, on name tags, etc. in the event they are selected. Our spreadsheet formulas don't work if an audition form says Abigail and the registration form says Abby, for example.

STEP TWO: RESULTS and REGISTRATION

Results will be posted on the NDACDA website by Monday, November 15th and music for each accepted student and each director will be sent out after the results are posted. In the event that an alternate takes the position of another student, the director will send the student's music on to the new participant.

Complete registration forms, and collect the registration fee by Friday, December 3.

Forms:

- Please submit one School Registration Form per school
- Please submit one Student Registration Form per student.
- All forms are completed online; no forms need to be mailed. Please keep the consent form for
 yourself and have it on hand at the conference in case we need to reference it with one of your
 students.

Registration fee:

- The fee of \$45 per student will cover the cost of music, T-shirt, dinner Friday evening, and lunch on Saturday.

- To pay by credit card, follow the directions in the School Registration Form.
- Schools whose registrations are sent 7 days past the deadline will be charged a \$50 late penalty fee.
- After the 7 days, alternates will be notified. Registered students who withdraw from Honor Choir forfeit their registration fee. Alternates who fill in for a previously registered student need not pay a registration fee.

Students need to be enrolled in choir the full school year to participate.

STEP THREE: CONFERENCE

Students will be responsible for their own transportation to Bismarck and to all rehearsals. Students must be chaperoned by a teacher or a parent. Regional and National ACDA Honor Choirs require that students be chaperoned by their parents when attending. While it is understood that not all schools are able to obtain parent chaperones, it is highly recommended by NDACDA.

Evening Concert: Featuring one song from each honor choir and other performing groups. Students wear their Honor Choir t-shirt and nice jeans.

Early Afternoon Concert: Featuring the Middle Level and Collegiate Honor Choirs

- Students must be in attendance at all rehearsals to participate in the Honor Choir event
- Concert tickets may be purchased each night for \$5 per person
